Deuteronomy 34; Joshua 1 and 2

Year 1, lesson 24

The spies survey the land, aided by Rahab.

God's reputation has preceded His people. ▲

Observation: *what does it say?*

Read Deut 34 and Joshua 1 and 2. Mark: *God, Moses, Joshua, land, Rahab, strong and courageous.*

1. In Deut 31:1–8. What does Moses tell Joshua to encourage him in his role as the next leader of the people?
2. Who buries Moses? Where is he buried?
3. What do the men viewing the land swear to Rahab?
4. God, through Joshua, tells the Israelites to be “strong and courageous”—what big thing are they about to do?
5. How does Rahab help the spies?

Interpretation: *what does the author mean?*

6. Read. Deut 32:48–52. Why is Moses not allowed to enter the promised land?
