How does God demonstrate His power? ▲

## **Observation: *what does it say?***

Read Joshua 3:1–4:24. Mark *Joshua, sons of Israel, ark of the covenant, Lord.*

1. Who is to step into the Jordan River first? What are they carrying?
2. What happens as they step into the water? Draw a picture.
3. What do the men take from the middle of the Jordan? What are they supposed to do with them?
4. What is the purpose for doing that?

## **Interpretation: *what does the author mean?***

5. In 3:5, the people are told to ‘consecrate themselves’. What does that mean? (Ex 19:10, Lev 11:45)
