Judges 2:6–3:6

Year 2, lesson 1

God's people quickly forget Him and serve other gods. They break their promises and God's anger is the result. What will happen to a stubborn people who will not serve God? ▲

Observation: *what does it say?*

Read Judges 2:6–3:6 . Mark *Lord/God, gods, evil, Joshua, judge, covenant.*

1. What did the sons of Israel do that was evil in the sight of the Lord?
2. What did God do when He was angry with them?
3. What caused God to pity the Israelites? What did He say? What did He do?

Interpretation: *what does the author mean?*

4. Judges 2:10 appears to be the reason that the Israelites sinned. What is the reason?
5. What commandment did the Israelites break? (See Exodus 20)
6. Why did God send judges? What was their purpose? Did it work?
