Observation: What does it say?

1. Read Luke 9:1–36 and Matthew 14:22–36. Mark key words: *God/pronouns, Jesus/pronouns, apostles/disciples/twelve, Peter/pronouns, pray/praying/prayer.*
2. Jesus tells the disciples what is going to happen to Him in the future. What does He say?
3. What were Peter and his companions doing while Jesus was praying in Lk 9:29?
4. Who was Jesus talking to and what were they talking about in Lk 9:28–36? What do you know about these two men? Give a short “biography” of each. (You can use the concordance in the back of the Bible to help you!)
5. Give the series of events in Matthew 14:22–36; list them in order.
6. According to Jesus, why was Peter unable to walk on the water for more than a short time?
7. What is the response of the disciples when Jesus gets into the boat and the wind stopped?
