Luke 10

Jesus continues His ministry and shares the parable of the Good Samaritan. Can you explain the meaning of the Good Samaritan?

Observation: What does it say?

1. *Review:* What is the theme of Matthew 13? Write it on the chart on p. 1613.
2. Read Luke 10. Mark key words: *God/Jesus/Holy Spirit/pronouns, city (underline all the names of the different cities in this chapter), heaven, hades.*
3. Who appoints and gives instructions? Who receives the instructions?
4. List the instructions that Jesus gives the 70 when He sends them out. Where are they going? What is their message?
5. According to Lk 10:16, when someone rejects you when you are telling about the kingdom of heaven, who are they really rejecting?
6. Where does Jesus pray in this chapter? What does He say?
7. What are the two questions that the lawyer asked Jesus in this chapter? According to Jesus, what are the answers to these questions?
8. Who welcomed Jesus into their home?

Interpretation: What does the author mean?

9. What does Jesus mean when He says “I am sending you out as lambs in the midst of wolves”? (Lk 10:3)

10. In Lk 10:19–20, Jesus says that He has given the 70 some amazing powers. However, they are not supposed to rejoice in that but rejoice that their names are recorded in heaven. What does He mean? What verse(s) tell you that He knows what is going on in heaven?

11. Jesus uses another parable to answer a question in this chapter. Can you give this parable a name? Be ready to share a “modern version” of this parable on Tuesday with the group.

12. What did Jesus mean that “Mary has chosen the good part”?

Application: therefore, what shall I do?

13. How are you like a “lamb among wolves?”

14. Is your name recorded in heaven? (Lk 10:20) How do you know?

15. Who is your neighbor? Give some examples.

16. Martha and Mary choose different ways to use their time with Jesus. Can you relate to Martha or Marty? How do you choose to use your time with Jesus?
